

Zap!

This activity works best in a small group setting.

Can participants spot the correctly spelled word? For this activity, each participant will need a writing utensil and multiple strips of paper. It is ideal to have them sit in a circle or around a table.

1. Give participants 30 seconds to all write the same word on their scrap of paper, *purposely misspelled*. (The time may be longer or shorter, depending on participants' level.)
2. Write that same word correctly on your piece of paper.
3. Collect all papers from the participants and shuffle them.
4. Hand each participant back a new piece of paper, face down so the word is not visible. You will also have a new piece of paper.
5. When you say “go,” everyone will flip their paper and look to see who has the correctly spelled word.
6. The first person to point to the correctly spelled word and say “**Zap!**” wins the round, and keeps the paper.
7. Play as many rounds as needed – the participant with the most cards at the end of the game is the winner! As everyone becomes familiar with this game, they can take turns being the one to write the word correctly.
